

Professor Dr. Syed Tufail Hussain Sherazi received Gold Medal Award

Prof. Dr. Syed Tufail Hussain Sheerazi of National Centre of Excellence in analytical Chemistry received the most coveted national honor of earning Gold Medal 2016 in Chemical Sciences by Pakistan Academy of Sciences in recognition of his outstanding research contribution in the field of **Chemical Sciences including Pharmaceutical Sciences**. This award comprises Rs.35, 000 cash, a Gold Medal and an acknowledgement certificate.

Dr. Anwar Nasim, the Chief Guest of the Ceremony and President Pakistan Academy of Sciences has given the Gold Medal Award to Dr. Sherazi in a Ceremony held in Pakistan Academy of Sciences on October 26, 2016. This award comprises Rs.35,000 cash, a Gold Medal, and an acknowledgement certificate.

Dr. Sherazi completed his postdoctoral study in McGill University in 2006. Presently he is serving as a Professor in National Centre of Excellence in Analytical Chemistry, University of Sindh, Jamshoro, Pakistan. Mainly research work is on Analytical Chemistry, Environmental Chemistry, Food Chemistry, Nanotechnology and Biotechnology. Dr. Sherazi has published 140 scientific papers in peer reviewed national and international journals of good repute with impact factor of 204 and author of 2 International books Chapters. He has produced 16 Ph. D. and 8 M. Phil research scholars. Currently, Dr. Sherazi is supervising 07 Ph. D. and 06 M. Phil research scholars. Dr. Sherazi presented his work in 27 International and 48 National conferences/symposia/seminars/workshops as an invited speaker.
